SUMMARY:

The project is focused on the individual students’ needs, developing their abilities in particular fields, increasing their achievement and to keeping them in the education system. A mechanism for differential funding of the school programmes is developed in order to be identified the individual interests of students and the children to be involved in preferred favorite subjects. The mechanisms are developed with the intention to reveal the students’ education deficits and obligatory activities that they find difficult. Inter-school initiatives and events are carried out assisting the development and presentation of obtained knowledge and skills and increasing the self-confidence of the students.

ACHIEVED RESULTS:

School mechanisms are elaborated to identify extracurricular activities focused on overcoming learning difficulties through students’ interests. 2 304 schools for 2016/2017 school year and 2 183 for 2017/2018 school year are involved in the project activities;

Thematic programmes are elaborated related to extracurricular activities by interests and overcoming learning difficulties – 17 570 thematic programmes on activities by interests and 11 955 thematic programmes on learning difficulties for 2016/2017 school year, and 16 500 thematic programmes on activities by interests and 12 089 thematic programmes on learning difficulties for 2017/2018 school year;

The total number of students who have attended extracurricular activities is 451 498 within the duration of the project implementation. In the period of 2016/2017 school years the students who have attended extracurricular activities are 322 305, while their number in 2017/2018 school year is 316 369;

A public monitoring model involving parents and other stakeholders has been elaborated;

2304 “Your class” Councils are established in each school involving parents, representatives of municipalities, extracurricular units, pedagogical teams, non-profit organizations, public bodies, former teachers, etc.
